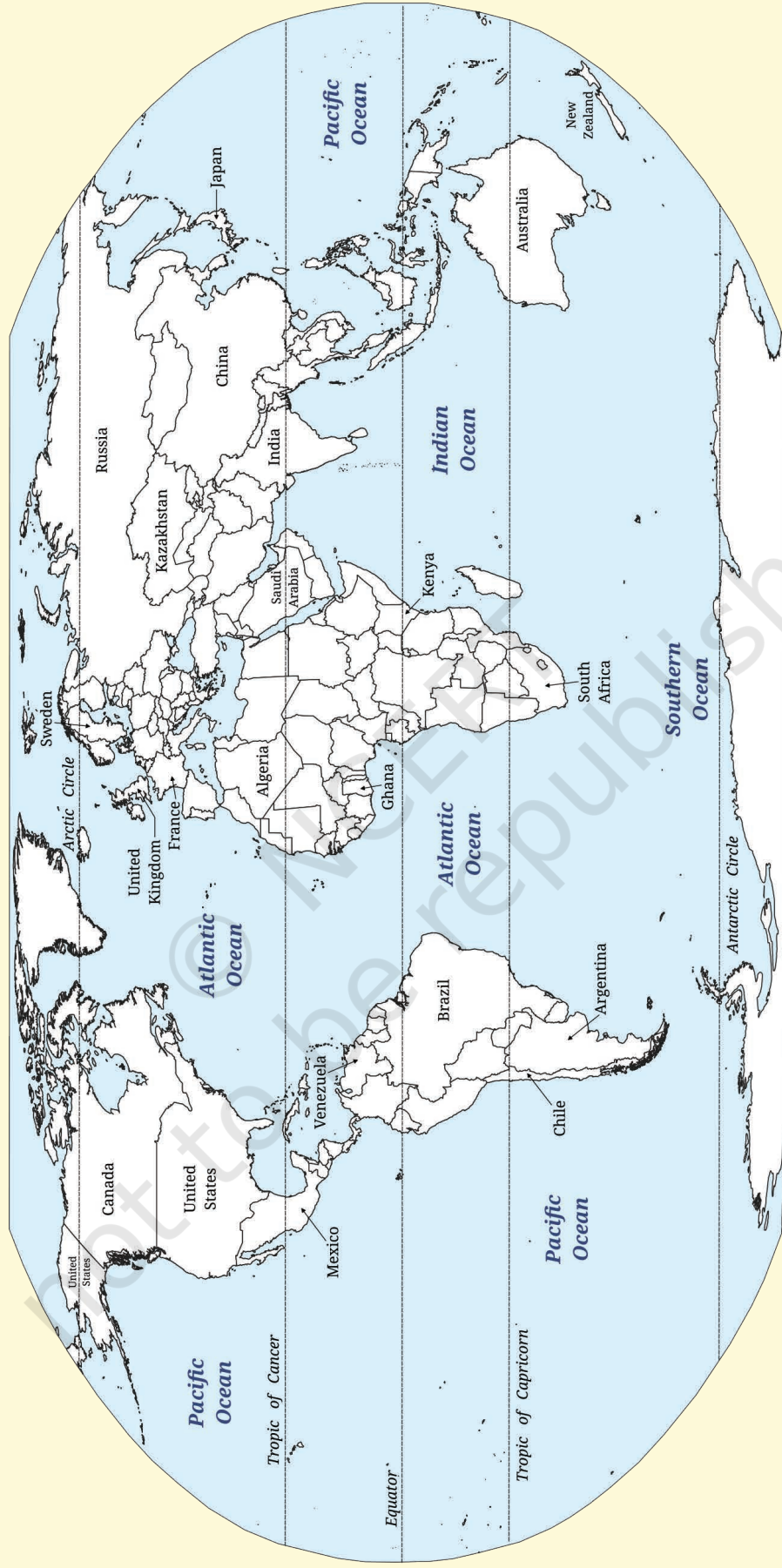
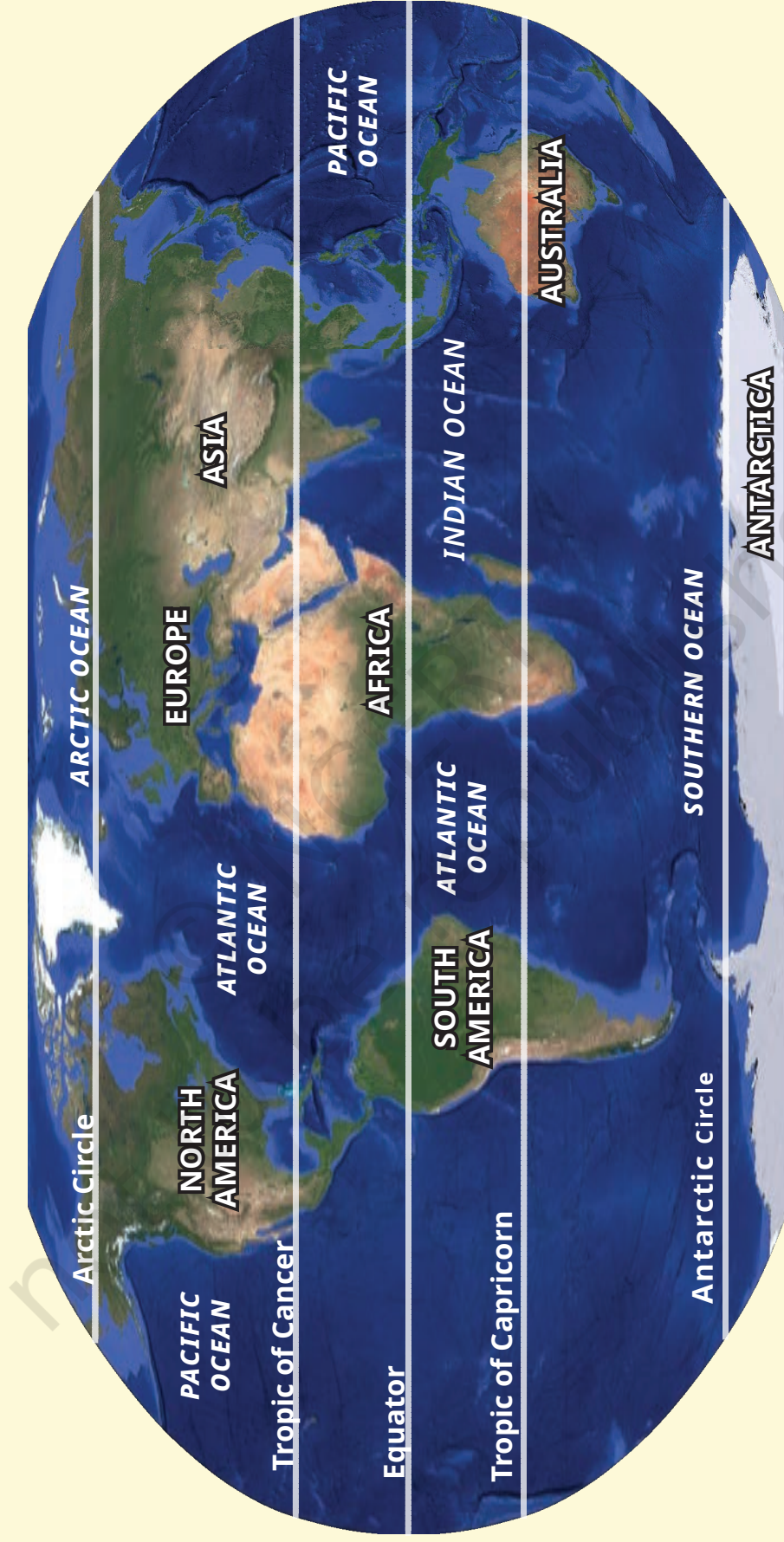




Political map of the world, with a few names of countries.

Glossary

Bleaching: A process of whitening or discolouration

Bonfire: A large fire made outside to burn unwanted things, or for pleasure

Breach: The act of breaking a law or contract

Calligraphy: Decorative writing

Cenotaph: A public monument built in memory of famous persons

Circumambulate: To walk around

Conscience: The part of a person that dictates what is right and what is wrong

Deciduous: That shed leaves annually

Decry: To criticise something as bad, often unnecessarily

Empathy: The ability to share someone's feelings by identifying with their situation

Felicity: Bliss; or the ability to express one's thoughts tellingly

Flax: A type of plant grown for its stem or seeds

Fluorescent: Which emits light naturally and glows in the dark

Indignation: Anger about a situation that you think is wrong or unfair

Interred: Buried

Jostling: Struggling or using force

Meander: With many twists and turns

Modest: Not large in size or amount; for a person, humble and unassuming

Muezzin: A man who calls Muslims to prayer

NASA: National Aeronautics and Space Administration

National Geographic Society: An organisation that works on exploring, researching, documenting and protecting the geography of the world

Parasol: A sunshade similar to a large umbrella

Penalise: To impose a fine or some punishment

Polyglot: Fluent in several languages

Polymath: A person who knows a lot about many different subjects

Preceptor: Teacher

Primates: A group of developed and intelligent mammals including humans, monkeys and apes

Proclamation: An official announcement

Promenade: A path for walking on leisurely, especially one built next to a river or the sea

Repressive: Brutal in imposing control by force

Sentinel: A person employed to guard something

Signature style: Creating work that is unique to a person or area

Soothsayer: A person who is believed to have the ability to know and tell what will happen in the future

Spotlight: Drawing attention to something by focusing on it

Tinge: A very slight amount of colour

Trajectory: The curved path that an object follows

Trapezoid: A four-sided flat shape with two parallel sides

Untenable: That cannot be maintained or defended against attack or objection

Vernacular: The language or dialect spoken by the common people in a particular country or region
